Queen Elizabeth II lives in London. She lives in **Buckingham Palace**, which is in Westminster.


The **Prime Minister** lives in London. He lives at **10 Downing Street**, which is also in Westminster.

a book with maps and charts.




capital city:

an object or feature of a place that is easily seen and recognised from a distance.




Big Ws

Edinburgh is the capital city of **Scotland**. Its famous landmark is the **Palace of Holyrood House** where the **Queen** stays when she visits Scotland.



Belfast is the capital city of **Northern Ireland**. Its famous landmark is **Belfast Castle**. The **Titanic** was also built there.



Cardiff is the capital city of **Wales**. Its famous landmark is the national stadium for the Wales rugby team – **The Millennium Stadium**.



There are **four seas** that surround the United Kingdom: the **Atlantic Ocean**, the **Irish Sea**, the **English Channel** and the **North Sea**.

United Kingdom



Compass points are used to show the direction of things, especially on a map.

- Cardiff is **west** of London.
- The Irish Sea is **east** of Belfast.
- The English Channel is **south** of London.

London is the capital city of **England**. **Chelsea**, **Arsenal**, **West Ham** and **Crystal Palace** football teams all have stadiums around London. It has many famous landmarks.
