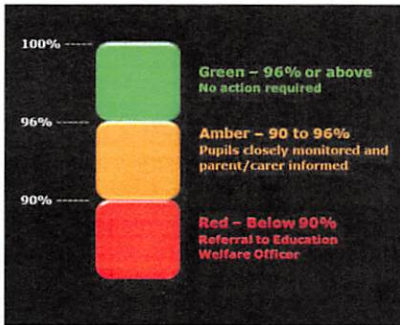

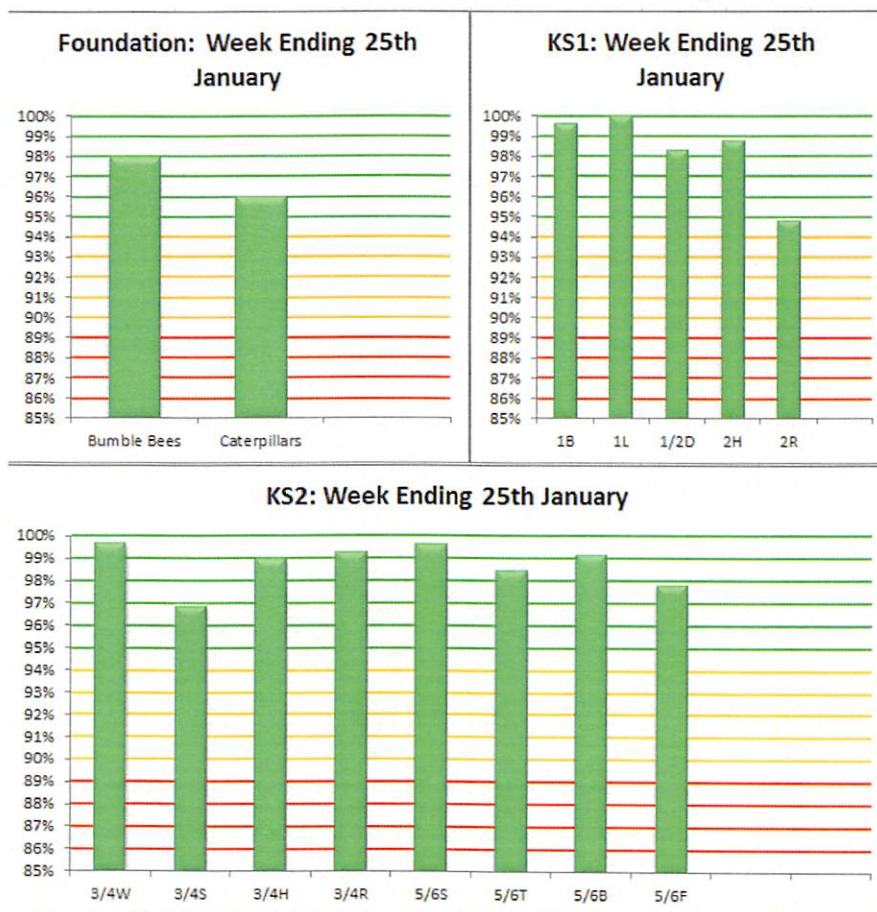
## WHOLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

### **General Messages:**

**Uniform & PE Kits** We would like to thank all parents and carers for your continued support with school uniform. The children always look smart in their **correct uniform** and **black school shoes**. We have noticed that many parents have not put their children's names in their school clothes and P.E. kits. ### Key Stage 1 News

Do fish have fingers?

This week, Year 1 and 2 have looked at REAL fish to investigate this question. In Science, we are focussing on the similarities and differences between animals to understand classification. We have really enjoyed this experience and it has helped improve our discussions in Science.
