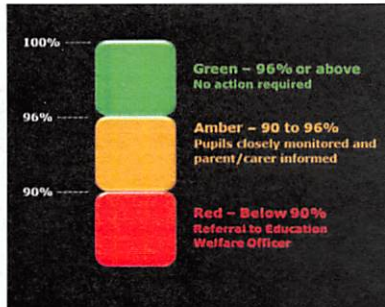

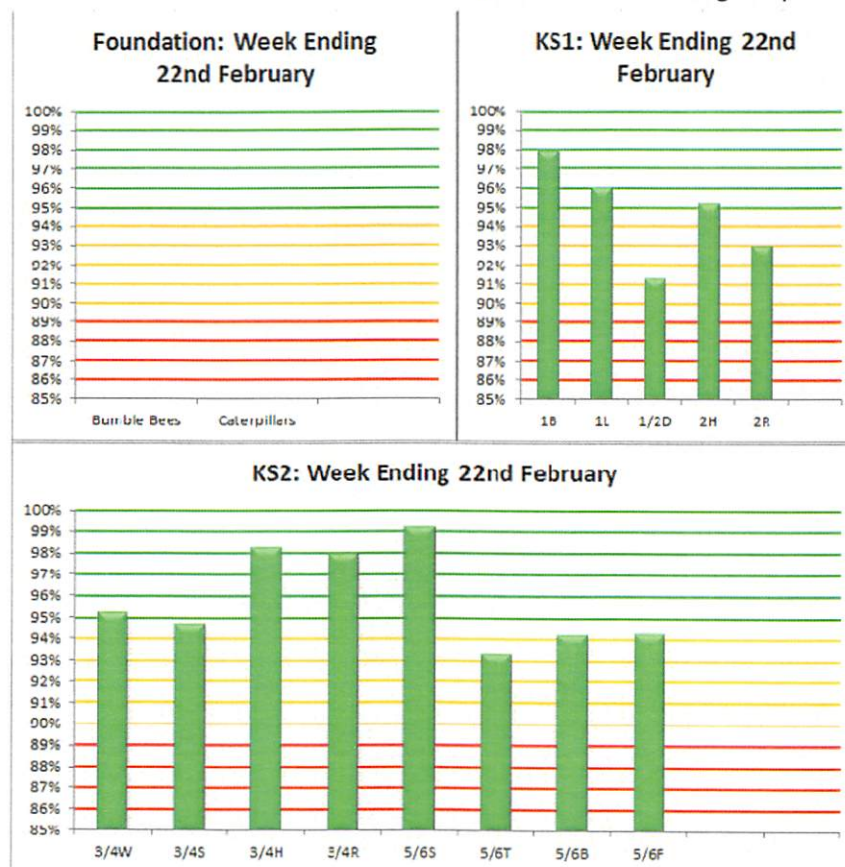


**WHOLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Key Stage 1 News

New half term, new topic and it is DINOSAURS! There are lots of exciting events this half term: World Book Day Friday 8th March, Comic Relief Day Friday 15th March, Year 2 Singing Festival Tuesday 19th March and finally Dinosaur Day on Thursday 28th March (£2 contribution).

Year 1 and 2 are busy learning about and creating riddles in English around their topic work. In maths, classes are doing a range of learning activities from counting in 5s to reading the time and looking at measure. In topic the children are creating a timeline and fact files on the different dinosaur periods and creatures. Whilst in science, the children continue to learn about the different types of animals.
