Places will be confirmed on Monday 25th March and booking will be made with the travel company on Tuesday 26th March.

The Tour Facts:

Depart School: Monday 30th September 2019

Return to School: Thursday 3rd October 2019

Destination: Liverpool

Mode of Transport: Coach

Purpose of the tour: To experience a residential visit together with the culture and attractions of a significant English City – Liverpool

Tour cost per pupil: £299. The trip will not be confirmed and booked if pupil numbers do not meet the minimum required by the tour company.

What is included in that cost: Full board accommodation (packed lunches during excursions) entry to all attractions. Proposed itinerary below

Initial Payment: Deposit of £30 to be received by no later than **Friday 22nd March 2019** – non-refundable after booking is confirmed with the travel company.
